Staff Safety Information

Welcome

Welcome to our project at Westfield Century City AMC - 10250 Santa Monica Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90067 on Sunday, May 15, 2022. Enclosed you will find safety and testing information for the event. We encourage all persons connected with the event to continue to follow COVID safety practices both on and off site.

Attendance at this event is contingent on a negative COVID-19 test result.

Face masks are recommended for all staff and crew. They are required where physical distance cannot be maintained e.g. Glam and Press Pit.

COVID-19 Testing

External and self-tests tests will be accepted (PCR or Antigen tests within 3 calendar days). Acceptable proof of a negative test includes a digital result from licensed laboratory, or a photograph of an at-home self-test. Photographs must show the date which the test was taken. External and self-test results will be verified on arrival.

Complimentary testing is available at the following locations and times. Photo identification is required.

Tests consist of an oral or nasal swab and will be provided by a healthcare professional. If testing upon arrival, allow 30 minutes prior to your call time for registration, testing and results.

Suspected or Confirmed Positive Results

If you have received a positive COVID-19 result, or are subject to quarantine requirements, you must not attend site. Instead, you should contact your representative; remain at your accommodation, quarantine and isolate in accordance with CDC guidelines. If you experience any symptoms, consult your healthcare provider.

Previous Positive Policy

A copy of a positive PCR test result or letter from a healthcare professional is required. Date of the positive test must be within 90 days of the event, but not in the last 10 days. Once verified by the event safety vendor, no testing required.

Arrival Onsite

Accreditation:

1st Floor Atrium between Bloomingdale's & Nordstrom in front of the Apple store.

Any staff testing on-site should allow 20 minutes before call time for registration, testing, and results. Once the check-in process is complete you will be issued a working credential.

Security

Government issued photo ID is required for access. The name on the photo ID must match the name on the list. No visitors or walk-ons are permitted.

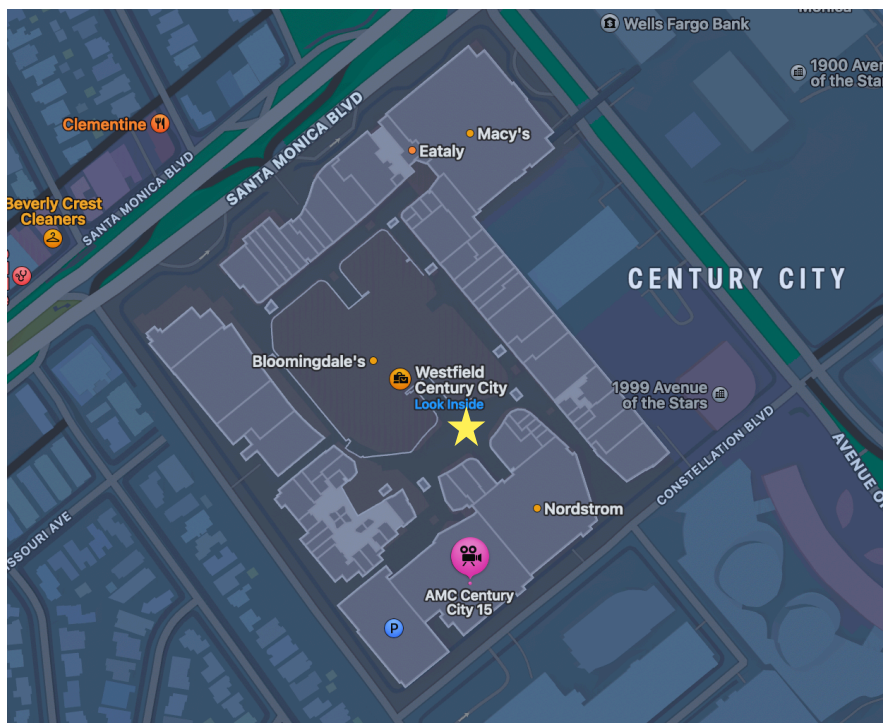
Photographs and social media are not permitted. Only access areas that are assigned to you.

Before You Arrive

Before you depart for site please ensure that you are fit and well.

If you are experiencing any of the symptoms below, or are in any doubt about your health, do not attend and contact your representative and healthcare provider.

You must answer “Yes” to the following questions:

- Have you tested negative for COVID-19 within 3 days?
- Can you confirm that you do not have any of the following symptoms that are common with COVID-19?
 - Fever or chills
 - Difficulty breathing
 - New or worsening cough
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Sore throat
 - Diarrhea or vomiting
 - Sustained fatigue or nausea
 - Sustained whole body muscle aches
 - Sustained new or unexpected headache
- Can you confirm that you have not had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the last 10 days?
 - Close contact includes the following:
 - Receiving an exposure notification from a Public Health Authority contract tracing system
 - Interacting with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 at a distance less than 6 feet/2 meters for 15 minutes or longer over a 24-hour period
 - Interacting with someone who is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms at a distance less than 6 feet/2 meters for 15 minutes or longer over a 24-hour period
 - Sharing a household with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 and is not able to isolate
 - Sharing a household with someone who is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and is not able to isolate

COVID Mitigation - Do Your Part



Health

Only attend if you are fit and well.

Pre-testing is required for all regardless of your vaccination status.

If you are in any doubt about your health, do not attend, contact your manager and healthcare provider.



Cleaning and Sanitization

Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer frequently throughout the day to reduce the spread of infections.

Routinely sanitize equipment and workstation.

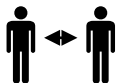


Face Masks and Face Shields

Apple reusable face masks or KN95 face masks are recommended indoors and outdoors.

Face masks and face shields are required for close-contact work.

Spare PPE will be available onsite.



Physical Distancing

6' Physical distance is recommended.

8' Physical distancing is recommended when talent is performing/presenting without a mask.

Site Safety



Fire

On hearing the fire alarm or an instruction to evacuate:

- Immediately leave the venue via the nearest available exit.
- Report to assembly point: in front of Gelsons on Century Park West

If you discover a fire take the following action:

- Raise the alarm by activating the nearest pull station or by contacting security.
- If trained and it is safe to do so attempt to tackle the fire with a portable fire extinguisher.
- Leave the venue via the nearest available exit.
- Report to assembly point: corner of in front of Gelsons on Century Park West

Do not re-enter the venue until instructed by an Emergency Responder that it is safe.



First Aid

Available from the event medic on Radio Channel 15.



Safety

- High visibility vests must be worn when working on the street.
- Hard hats must be worn during overhead and rigging operations.
- Only work in areas that have been assigned to you.
- Work to your hazard assessment.
- PPE must be used where required.
- Give priority to public during loading and unloading.
- Hearing protection is required during sound checks and performances.
- Report all accidents, incidents and near misses to the Production Manager.



Security

- Immediately report suspicious behavior to Security Manager on Radio Channel 16.
- Protect your personal property.
- Wear your credential at all times whilst on the premises.
- All persons are subject to security searches and screening upon entry and at other times within their area of work.
- CCTV is in operation for the purposes of security and safety management.
